



Membership Categories and Fees

Membership of CIDEF is classified into four categories as follows: Professional Members; Student Members and Associate Members.

(A) Chartered Professional Membership

To qualify for this category of membership, an applicant is required have a degree in Development Finance from an affiliated university. These members are awarded professional status and are internationally recognized and given a Chartered Status (Chartered Development Finance Analyst) with post nominal letters CDFA able to be displayed after their names;

Benefits of Professional Membership

- They are allowed to use CDFA after their names- e.g. John Smith, CDFA;
- Access to a global network of development finance practitioners and specialists;
- Access to some research information on development finance;
- Discounted fees for CIDEF's conferences, seminars and workshops;
- Discounted fees for CIDEF's training programs;
- Members can contribute articles to Development Finance Agenda Magazine.

(B) Student Membership

To qualify for this category of membership, an applicant is required have enrolled in a Development Finance degree program in an affiliated university. This membership class is for people working towards CDFA Status.

Benefits of Student Membership

- Access to outstanding publications, educational resources and research information on development finance;
- Discounted fees for CIDEF's events worldwide- including training programs, conferences, workshops etc.;

(C) Associate Membership

This membership is for individuals working in the development finance sector, interested in development finance activities or pursuing a qualification in development finance at an affiliated university.
