**DR. ISAAC OTCHERE** is a Professor of Finance at the Sprott School of Business, Carleton University in Ottawa, Canada. Prior to joining Carleton University in July 2006, he taught at the University of New Brunswick (Canada) and University of Melbourne (Australia). He has a Ph.D. in Finance, Master of Management Studies (MMS) Finance (Carleton University, Canada), M.A. in Public Administration (Carleton University, Canada), and BSc. Administration (Accounting- (University of Ghana)). Dr. Otchere is also a Chartered Accountant.

He has extensive international research and teaching experience. An award-winning professor, Dr. Otchere has taught a range of Finance courses at the executive education, PhD, masters, and undergraduate levels in many countries including Canada, Australia, Singapore, Ukraine, Trinidad, China, Colombia, UAE, South Africa, and Ghana. He has held Visiting Scholar positions at the University of Cape Town Graduate School of Business, Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology (KNUST) Business School in Ghana, University of Ghana Business School, and GIMPA and the University of Dubai.

Dr. Otchere has received several teaching and research awards from different universities in Canada and Australia. He has published extensively in highly ranked peer review finance journals and has made numerous presentations at different finance conferences. He is a reviewer for many Finance, Economics, and International Business journals. He is a Resource Person for the African Economic Research Consortium (AERC) and a Fellow of the Carnegie African Diaspora Program based in the USA. His scholarship has received external recognition from prominent international financial institutions including the World Bank, IMF/African Institute.
